SUBJECT

OFFICIAL TRAVEL

The purpose of this amendment is to implement the Deputy Secretary of Transportation's recent delegation of authority to approve invitational travel to major awards ceremonies. Accordingly, the basic order is amended as follows:

Section 3.02 is amended to read as follows:

3.02 Travel of Private Individuals and Executive Reservists:

- 1 Only the Maritime Administrator may authorize travel of private individuals to confer on official matters, including members of advisory committees (boards) and Congressional boards of visitors, etc.; and travel of executive reservists under the National Defense Executive Reserve program as provided in paragraph 1-0409 of the manual.
- 2 Pursuant to delegation of authority by the Deputy Secretary of Transportation, the Associate Administrator for Administration is redelegated authority to approve attendance of selected individuals, at Government expense using invitational travel authority, at major award ceremonies.


