**September 2001 CHANGES:**

- Navy vessel VANCOUVER entered the Suisun Bay Reserve Fleet in Reimbursable Custody status on September 10th.

**NOTES:**

- The scrapping of WASHINGTON and EXPORT COMMERCE continues; both are approximately 70% completed.
- Esco Marine of Brownville, TX has been issued a notice to proceed for the scrapping of GEN ALEX M PATCH. She is expected to be towed from the JRRF in October 2001.
- A letter of bid acceptance was issued to CCC Marine for the sale of BENJAMIN ISHERWOOD for use as a NATO oiler. Sale closing is scheduled for October 2001.
- A review of past records indicates that METEOR, COMET, SHOSHONE, NORTHERN LIGHT, POTOMAC, AMERICAN EXPLORER, SOUTHERN CROSS, ALATNA, CHATTAHOOCHEE and NODAWAY, originally transferred to the RRF in 1984 from MSC, are officially still Navy titles. The process has been initiated to officially transfer these 10 titles to MARAD; their status as MARAD NDRF assets in the Reserve Fleet Inventory will not be effected during this process.
