**CHANGES:**

- + FLORIKAN, ASR 9, and RECLAIMER, ARS 42, entered SBRF on 10/06/00 for reimbursable custody pending title transfer to MARAD for their disposal.
- ☐ JOHN HENRY, a shallow draft heavy lift ship, O.N. 599294, departed BRF on 10/17/00. This vessel was withdrawn from the NDRF by a Congressionally authorized competitive sale, restricted to humanitarian organizations. The vessel was sold to World Wide Water Foundation. It can be recalled to RRF duty in time of war or national emergency.
- + Open lighter barges, YC 824 & 826 entered SBRF on 10/17/00 for indefinite term reimbursable custody pending disposition by NAVSEA.
- ☐ Seven Army fuel barges, in storage at SBRF since 11/99, have been condensed into one vessel entry so as not to overstate fleet workload. The status remarks column notes the true number of barges.

**NOTES:**

- ☐ Per U.S. TRANSCOM directive "Ready Reserve Force (RRF) Program Guidance FY02 (sic)-FY07", dated 14 Feb 2000, the following breakbulks have been downgraded from the RRF to NDRF - Generally Militarily Useful: BANNER, COURIER, GULF BANKER, GULF TRADER, PIONEER COMMANDER, PIONEER CONTRACTOR, CAPE ALAVA, NORTHERN LIGHT, CAPE CATAWBA, CAPE CHALMERS, CAPE COD, LAKE, SCAN, and CAPE BON, effective on Oct. 1st, 2000.
- MAINE, WASHINGTON, and OHIO were listed as MARAD Design T2-SE-A2, however, these vessels were converted to Seatrain rail car carriers between 1977 - 78, consequently the entry in the "MA DESIGN" column has been changed to "SeatrainConv".
